Departure of Board Chair

POMEROY, WA – The commissioners of Garfield County Hospital District were informed last night of the resignation of their chairman. Roger Dumbeck cited personal reasons for stepping down from the board but affirmed his support of the Hospital District in a letter to the district administrator.

“We are very sorry to see Roger leave” said CEO, Andrew Craigie. We respect his decision and certainly appreciate his many years of dedicated service as a member of our board, in particular his leadership as President.” Dumbeck has served on the board since August of 2005, filling the partial term of his predecessor and then re-elected to office in January of last year. The normal term for a hospital district commissioner is six years. The commissioners of the district will now have to appoint a replacement within 90 days. Commissioner, Secretary Jim Maves will serve as interim President until the board takes action on a replacement for Dumbeck.
